Anatomy & Physiology

100 hour curriculum with Carol-Anne Bickerstaff

There are so many wonders in our world, but none more wondrous than the human body. Anatomy in Action is about that incomparable structure. Anyone with an interest to learn (or re-learn!) anatomy and physiology is welcome to attend.

As a science, anatomy is often defined as the study of the structure of an organism and the relationship of its parts. Physiology is the study of the functions of living organisms and their parts. This course explores how anatomical structures are designed to perform specific functions. By knowing the structure of the healthy body, you will be better prepared to understand both your own body and the factors affecting health and disease.

Anatomy in Action, a 100 hour curriculum, emphasizes concepts required for entry into more advanced courses and success in a practical work-related environment requiring knowledge of anatomy and physiology.

The instructor employs Interactive Accelerated Learning techniques to enliven textbook anatomy and physiology in a whole new way. These techniques enable students to learn quickly with greater understanding and recall. You will learn the basics of anatomy and physiology with an instructor who teaches you *how* to learn while you learn.

Carol-Anne Bickerstaff has been designing and teaching 30, 60, 90, and 100 hour anatomy courses since 1985. Designed specifically for the needs of the alternative health community, Anatomy in Action courses have been set up in conjunction with the Vancouver Homeopathic Academy, Sourcepoint Shiatsu Clinic, the Vancouver School Board, the Jin Shin Do Association, and other alternative health studies.
